Dear Valued Shareholder:

Our mission is to help clients to build and preserve their wealth over the long term, and we believe that this is best done by providing a broadly diversified group of investment strategies. In keeping with this mission, we carefully evaluate our entire mutual fund family on an ongoing basis, and we have determined that shareholders' interests would be best served by liquidating the AllianceBernstein Multi-Market Strategy Trust. The Trust's small size results in a relatively high total expense ratio.

We also believe that other AllianceBernstein mutual funds can offer investment strategies to help you achieve your investment goals. Our family of portfolios is broad and spans the range of fixed income categories, along with growth, value, and specialty equity styles. We hope you'll take this opportunity to carefully review your portfolio with your financial advisor to determine which of AllianceBernstein's mutual funds best meets your needs and investment strategy.

We've tried to make the transition to alternative funds easier by waiving the contingent deferred sales charge for shareholders of the Trust. Also, we've waived sales charges for Trust shareholders who exchange their shares for shares of another AllianceBernstein fund. Possible alternative funds that you may wish to consider further include:

- The AllianceBernstein Short Duration Portfolio¹, which is designed for investors who seek safety of principal and a moderate rate of taxable income;
- The AllianceBernstein U.S. Government Portfolio², whose objective is to generate a high level of current income, consistent with prudent investment risk;

¹ The Portfolio invests predominantly in U.S.-based securities rated A or better, and seeks to maintain an average duration of one to three years. It chooses from a wide variety of fixed income securities: U.S. government and agency securities, asset-backed securities, corporate bonds, mortgage-related securities, inflation-protected securities and others. Through extensive ongoing research, we seek to identify those fixed income securities with the highest expected return potential in relation to their risks in the current market. As the markets change, fixed income securities are bought and sold to maintain the highest return potential at the best level of interest-rate risk.

² The Portfolio invests, under normal circumstances, at least 80% of the value of its total assets in U.S. government securities and repurchase agreements and forward contracts relating to U.S. government securities. The Portfolio may invest the remaining 20% of the value of its total assets in non-U.S. government securities, including mortgage-related and asset-backed securities. The Portfolio will not invest in any security rated below BBB or Baa.

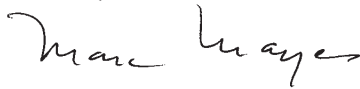
